Jerry Adamczyk announced that the SaddleBrooke Coin Club will begin meeting again once summer is over. As more information becomes available, I will pass it on.

Three More Quarter Dollar Designs

Along with Dr. Sally Ride and Maya Angelou, three more American women will join the 2022 list. First, Wilma Mankiller will be on a quarter dollar because she was the “first woman to serve at the Cherokee Nation’s principal chief, on Dec. 14, 1985. [The coin’s] reverse...depicts Mankiller with a resolute gaze to the future. The wind is at her back, and she is wrapped in a traditional shawl. To her left is the seven-pointed star of the Cherokee Nation. Additional inscriptions are PRINCIPAL CHIEF and, in the Cherokee Language, ‘Cherokee Nation.’”

Second, we will see Adelina Otero-Warren on a quarter dollar because she was the “first Hispanic woman to run for a seat in the U.S. House of Representatives, in 1922, and the first female superintendent of public schools in Santa Fe, New Mexico. [The coin’s reverse] features a facing waist-up portrait of her with an inscription in Spanish translating to ‘Votes for Women,’ VOTO PARA LA MUJER.”

Third, a quarter dollar will honor Anna May Wong for being “the first Chinese American movie star in Hollywood in a career that would span more than four decades. [the coin’s reverse] features an image of Anna May Wong striking a classic dramatic pose. The inscriptions, arranged to read as they might in a movie poster from the era, are UNITED STATES OF AMERICA PRESENTS ANNA MAY WONG IN QUARTER DOLLAR.”

Education Meeting

Terry Caldwell gave a presentation on sales tax tokens during the depression. They were made of different materials: pressed cotton fiber, aluminum, copper, plastic with patterns of holes in them in different colors. The value of the token was a tenth of a cent or a thousandth of a dollar. They were used for the taxes on small purchases such as five and ten cent amounts.

Eventually they were phased out, but a few states continued to use them for quite a while. Kansas was the first state to suspend/stop usage in mid-1939 and Missouri was the last state to stop using the sales tax tokens in 1961.

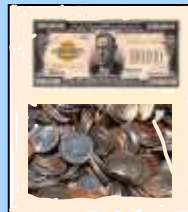


